## NEED A REBATE?

### Health Insurance Plan

All students registering at UPEI pay a premium for health insurance. Those who are already participants in a similar plan may receive a rebate of this fee by applying at the Student Union Office, before 31 January, with proof of alternate coverage. Those applying after that date will be rebated but on a pro-rated basis. We suspect that many students are not aware of the extent of their coverage, i.e. that they may receive prescribed drugs without charge at local drugstores by showing their student I.D. card. For out-of-town drugstores students should get a receipt and present it to the Student Union Office for reimbursement. Also, many students do not realize that this plan covers them to 31 August.
