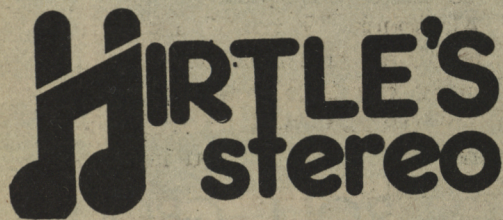
## Survival plans
