

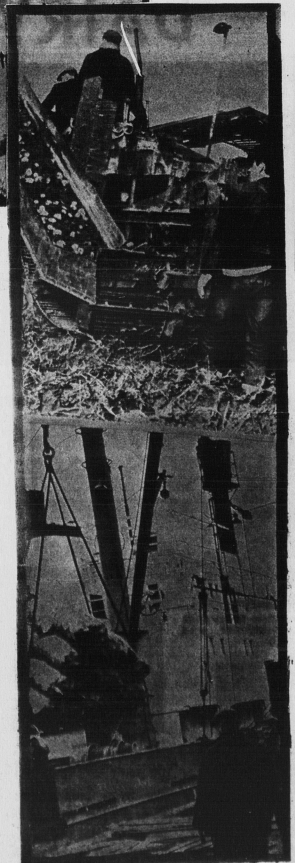
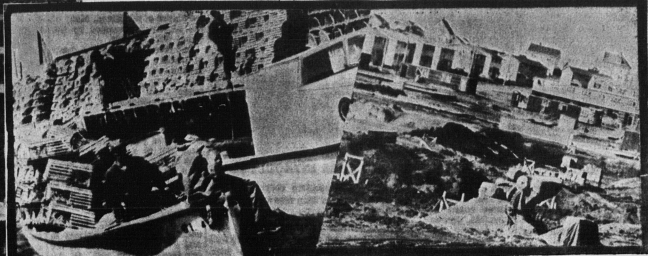
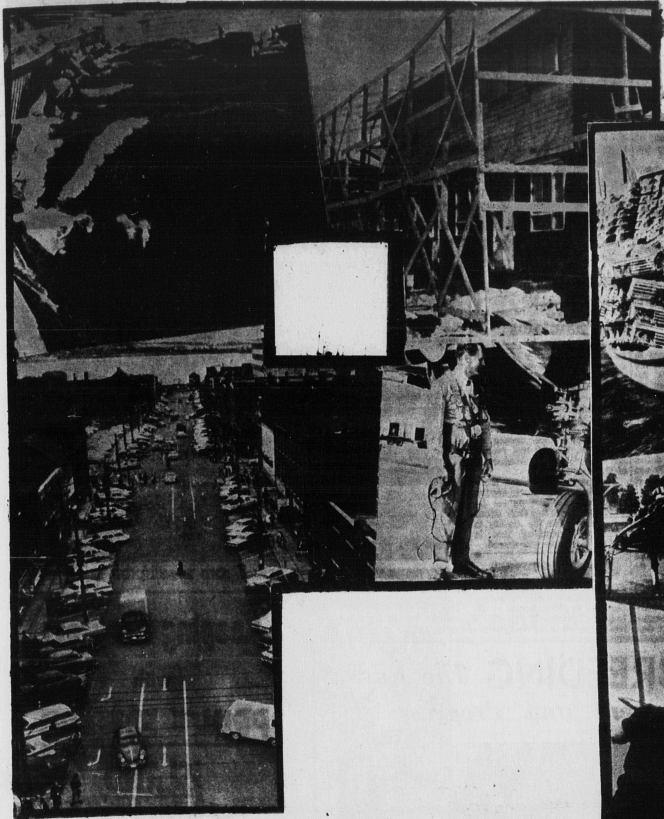

Island of Achievement

Prince Edward Island's March of Progress — social, cultural, economic — has seldom been more pronounced than during the 12 months of 1962.

The Island's basic industry, agriculture, was given new hope as the tremendous success of the still young tobacco industry, renewed emphasis on beef production and the signing of the ARDA agreement with Ottawa brightened the economic picture.
