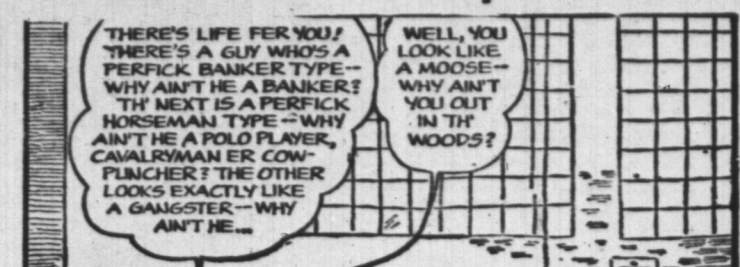

LONDON (Reuters)—A British nuclear disarmament group announced plans to send two women and three men to the Sahara Desert in a bid to prevent the forthcoming tests of France's first atomic weapons. The volunteers, including Rev. Michael Scott, a leader in the ban-the-bomb movement, hope to talk French technicians and others out of exploding the weapons. The direct action committee against nuclear war told reporters.
