Faster Delivery Claim Expected

The claim of expedited service that would cut 24 hours from the present time table on deliveries of commodities from the mainland, will likely feature the application of Canadian National Transportation Limited to operate regular inter-provincial motor vehicle service between this province and the mainland, it was learned yesterday from F.A. Large, QC.

The Charlottetown lawyer will represent the petitioners in a hearing before the Public Utilities Commission here on June 25.

The company now has a franchise for a limited, or intermittent service between Charlottetown and Moncton, Mr. Large explained.

SEES ADVANTAGE
Mr. Large emphasized the advantage, as he sees it, of having the CNR load commodities less than carload but quantity into a truck and send it to the Island immediately, rather than have it wait 24 hours in a shed at Moncton until the following day's train departure time.

The application will be opposed, it was learned yesterday from a spokesman for the truckers, but no details were immediately available.

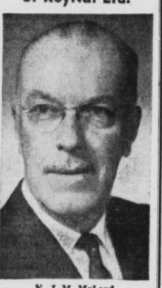
