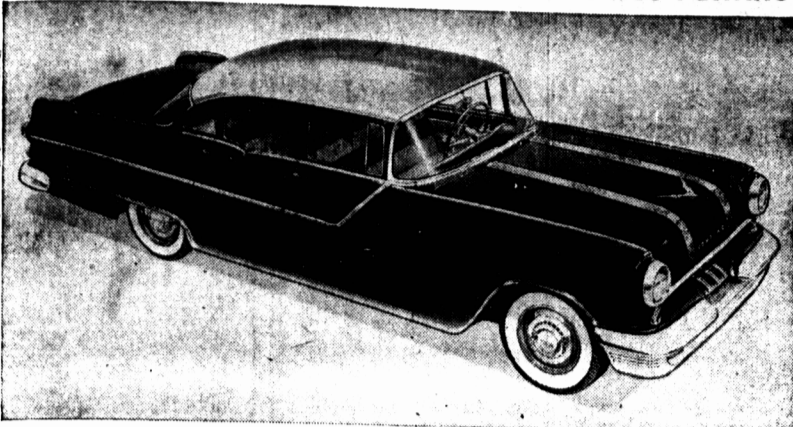


ADDED POWER, "LUXURY" RIDE IN FUTURISTIC 1955 PONTIAC
