WINNIPEG, March 26 - (CP) - Prices on the somewhat irregular today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with rye and flax advancing and oats and barley losing early gains to generally record small losses at the close. Upturns in United States markets were reflected here in early trade. However, when the American markets turned lower, the local market sold off. Commercial demand again was thin, with shippers taking oats and buying for American account coming into flax and rye. Trading was dull for the most part but speeded up toward the close.
