### Says Britain In Urgent Need Of Atom Power

WASHINGTON, (CP)—Sir Edwin Plowden, head of Britain's atomic energy authority, said Monday his country may go ahead of the United States in developing commercial atomic power because its needs are "very urgent."

After paying a courtesy call on President Eisenhower, Plowden told newspaper men that Britain quite likely will get into the atomic power field on a major basis ahead of the United States. Plowden was accompanied to the White House by Lewis Strauss, chairman of the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission. Strauss toured British atomic installations last year and Sir Edwin now is returning the visit. His inspection in the U.S. has been confined to civilian nuclear projects.

Asked which country is ahead—the United States or Britain—in development of atomic power for civilian purposes, Sir Edwin replied: "I don't think either side is ahead."
