CANADEM

CANADEM, the Canadian Resource Bank for Democracy and Human Rights, is now accepting applications from individuals or organizations wishing to put forward the names of individual youth for the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade's Youth International Internship Program (YIIP). CANADEM-sponsored YIIP interns will participate in a variety of human rights or peace building training and delivery programs.

Applicants:

*must be Canadian citizens with a valid Canadian passport or landed immigrants legally entitled to work in Canada and with a valid passport.

*must be between the ages of 18 and 30.

*should hold a college or university degree in the social or political sciences, such as international relations, international development, area studies, law, or other professional area, or present other suitable qualifications (university programs must be completed by April/May 1998).

*must be either unemployed or underemployed in their field of study, that is, be employed outside of their field of expertise.

*should possess a broad understanding of human rights, peace building and democracy issues, either through their area of study or volunteer work.

*must be available for 6 to 9 months.

*should be prepared to share some of the costs of the internship (by means of an in-kind contribution and/or lower earnings).

*must obtain appropriate immunizations and satisfy all travel and visa requirements.

Additional assets include:

*second language skills.

*some experience in area such as human rights or peace building—either volunteer, work or study-related—for example, membership in Canadian university-based human rights or peace building organizations such as Amnesty International.

*volunteer experience in other areas, for example, in cultural or similar associations.
