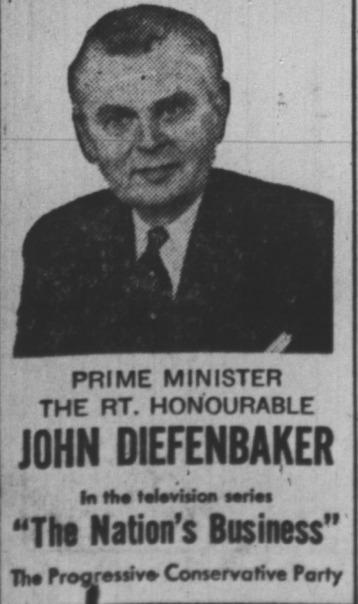

FAMOUS HANDS South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

WEST: ♠ 878, ♥ KJ4, ♦ KJ3, ♣ 732. EAST: ♠ KJ2, ♥ 9752, ♦ KJ4, ♣ 942. SOUTH: ♠ AQ10, ♥ 883, ♦ 765, ♣ AQ108.

Dear Mr. Becker: Many, many years ago I was playing in a rubber bridge game and held the West hand. The passage of time has blunted my memory and I do not recall the bidding, but I do remember the final contract was six notrump played by South, and I likewise remember the hand in full, card for card, because of the indelible impression it made upon me at the time.

It was the luckiest hand for declarer I ever encountered in all my experience. I led a spade and South won the king with the ace. He led a diamond to the ten, the double finesse succeeding, after which he played a club to the ten with the same effect.

There is no point in my laboring you with further details because, as you can see, every double finesse in every suit worked and South wound up making 5.00.

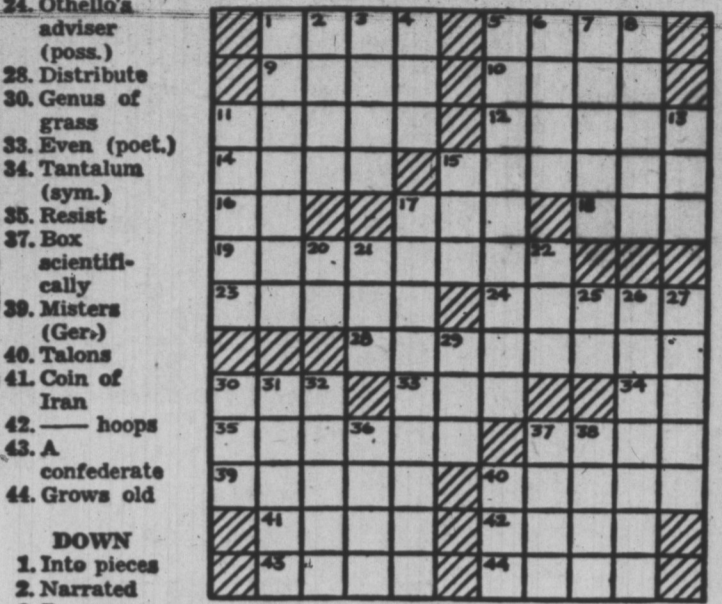

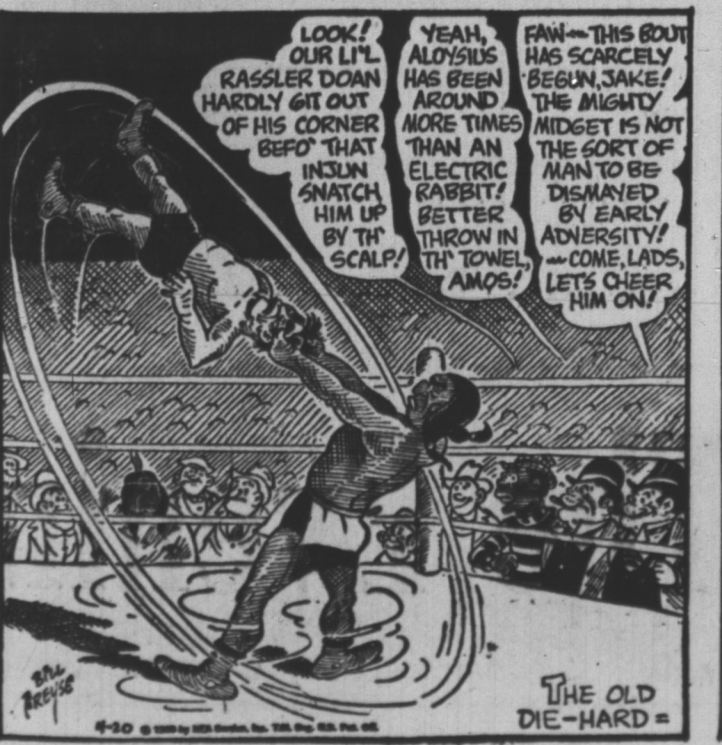

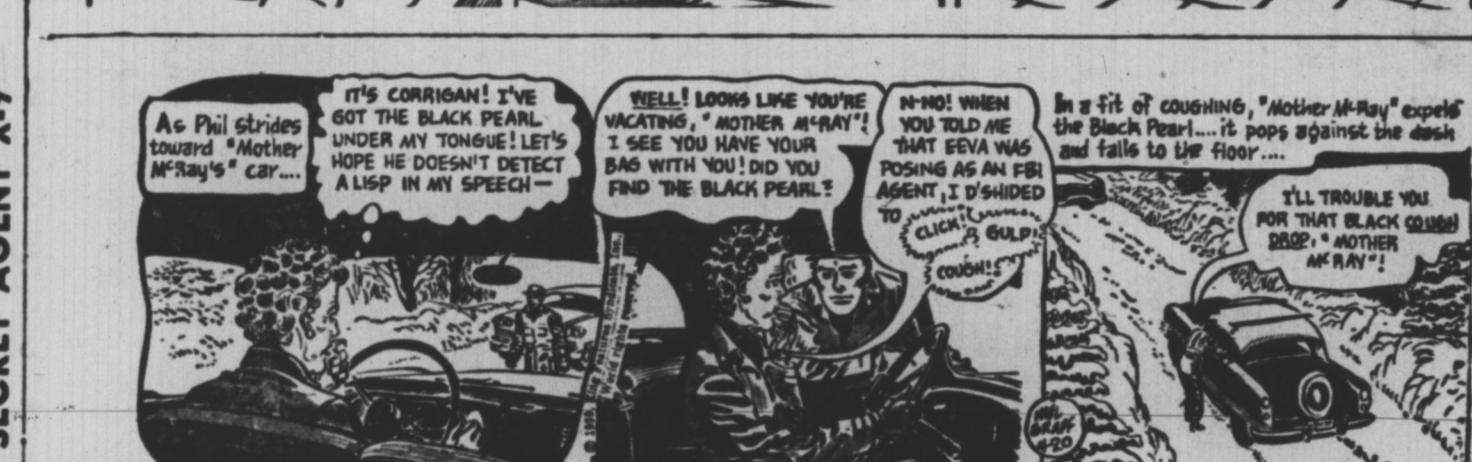
