

### Fog Cuts Into Russian Visit To Nfld. Ports

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—Three RCAF Otter aircraft carrying the Russian fisheries delegation swung away from the third and final stop of a visit to south coast fishing centres and headed back to St. John's Friday as fog threatened to roll in.

A fog bank hovered a mile off shore while the Russians led by Fisheries Minister A. A. Ishkov, 51, inspected fish plants in the towns of Fortune and Grand Bank. It had begun moving toward shore as the planes headed for Burin, last stop on the Russians' tour of Newfoundland fishing stations, so Burin's fish plant was dropped from the itinerary.

Some of the officials who visited the northeast coast Thursday, including Russian Deputy Fisheries Minister Igor M. Semenov, did not go on the south coast trip.

Alexander M. Verevkin, Soviet deputy fisheries minister and fisheries scientist Peter A. Moiseyev, the other members of the official party, accompanied Mr. Ishkov as did Soviet Ambassador Dmitri Chuvpina, George Clark, Canada's deputy fisheries minister, and other officials and reporters.

Much of the fish processing is done manually in some of the northeast coast plants visited Thursday and the Russians while polite, were not impressed.

Mr. Semenov explained that Thursday's trip was to give the Russians an idea of the beginnings of Newfoundland's industry and Friday's to show them how much progress was being made.

In the relatively new modern plant in Grand Bank and Fortune practically all processing is done mechanically.

**SNAP WHEELBARROW**  
The Russians showed most interest in plate freezers used for preparing fish sticks and, of all things, a wheelbarrow. They were struck by the design and possibly the color of the red, rubber-tired metal barrow used in the Grand Bank plant. Mr. Moiseyev wheeled it outside where he and Mr. Verevkin photographed it.

(Top Record-Holder in Masters' Individual Championship Play)

East dealer. Neither side vulnerable.

**NORTH**  
♠ 4 4 3  
♥ Q 5

The bidding:

Opening lead—seven of hearts.

As this column has pointed out before, most of the points which are lost to par by the average player, whether in bidding or play, are on the easy hands and not the tough ones. Maybe this is because the easy hands are much more common than the difficult ones, and there are, therefore, more opportunities to go wrong.

Be that as it may, South demonstrated the point in today's hand when he got a heart lead which he won with dummy's queen. Having gotten by the first hurdle, when the queen held, he lost control by playing the king and one of diamonds, learning that East now had a diamond

trick. Since it was not feasible to make the hand without the diamond suit, he led one which East won with the queen. East thereupon shifted to the queen of spades, trapping South's king, and causing South endless misery and a one trick set. All the time, the queen of hearts having held, South had a sure thing going by proper manipulation of the pastboards.

South had nine positive tricks, if, after playing the king and another diamond, he finessed the jack. Even if the finesse lost there would be nine certain tricks; two hearts, four diamonds and three clubs.

Clearly, in this case, where the finesse assures the contract and the play for the drop endangers it, the finesse becomes the mandatory play. All rules in bridge are made to be broken at the appropriate time.

The danger of a line of play which subjects the spade king to attack far outweighs the slight advantage of playing for the drop of the diamond queen. Making the contract is the first consideration.

### Russian Fired By U. N. For Espionage

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP)—Viktor Ivanovich Petrov, a Russian, has been fired by the UN and sent home for trying to get secret information on American aircraft from an American.

This was disclosed Friday in official announcements at the UN and in Washington. It was the third time in UN history that a Soviet national has lost his job at the UN because of attempted espionage.

Petrov, 31, was reported to have left for Russia Thursday with his wife, Valentina, and young son, Alexei.

He had held an \$8,000-a-year job in the Russian translating section of the UN secretariat since 1952.
