

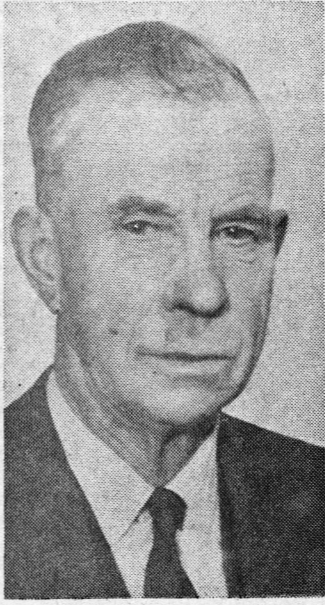


GRADUATE INTO C.G.I.T.
