Mr. Wilde is now completing his arrangements for his trip to New Zealand and Australia. Before he leaves America he will publish some papers, upon which he has been engaged during the summer.

It is confidently asserted that Mr. Gladstone intends to retire from Parliament before another session takes place. He entered public life when a very young man, and is now in his seventy-third year. He has done perhaps more arduous public work than any man living of his age.

The Sun's London special says that Lord Randolph Churchill will come in practically as leader of the Opposition when Parliament re-assembles. In a conservative and executive sense, Mr. Cross will be its leader, but as far as the definition of its policy, outlining of its course and shaping of its aggression are concerned, they lie in the hands of Churchill.

A special London despatch to the Sun says:—Lord Randolph Churchill is the best-abused and most thoroughly caricatured public man in England except the Prime Minister. The Spectator draws a comparison between him and Lord Beaconsfield. "Disraeli attacked Sir Robert Peel with a rapier," it says, "not with a dust shovel; with a weapon that pierced, not a tool that shattered. His abuse might have been uttered by Charles Fox in a rage, but Lord Randolph's by a blasphemous cabman." This is called forth by Lord Randolph's intemperate criticism of Mr. Gladstone's Irish policy. But Lord Randolph for all that is a very successful public man, and he fills the popular eye at present to a degree that must inevitably lead to high preferment.
