LOUIS, (AP) — Eddie (the Hat) Stanky was fired as St. Louis Cardinal manager Saturday and replaced by Harry (the Hat) Walker, manager of the club's Rochester farm team since 1952 and a former Cardinal outfielder. August A. Busch Jr., brewery owner and club president, said Walker was signed for the rest of the 1955 season. No salary terms for Walker were disclosed and Busch said "we will discuss his future after this season is over."
