### Strange But True

The Hidasta Indians of the New World believe that every natural object has its spirit. To these spirits considerable respect is due, but not equally to all. For example, the spirit of the cottonwood tree is supposed to possess an intelligence which properly approached, may help the redman in his undertakings; whereas the spirits of shrubs and grasses are of little account.

When the Missouri River goes on the rampage in the spring, and carries away part of the shore-line, it is said that the spirit of the fallen trees cry out loudly while their roots still cling to the soil. The Iroquois believed that each species of the plant family had its own spirit, and to these spirits they were accustomed to return thanks. The Wanka of Eastern Africa fancy that every coconut tree has its own spirit. The natives of the Fiji Islands will never eat a coconut without first asking its permission—"May I eat you, my Chief?" And among the Indians of British Columbia young fry address the following prayer to the sunflower before they eat the first roots of the season: "I inform thee that I intend to eat thee. Mayest thou help me to ascend so that I may always be able to reach the top of mountains—I ask this of thee, Sunflower-root. Thou art the greatest of all in mystery."

so do not cut down an old monarch. Sometimes they set up old trees that have fallen and smear them with blood, "to appease the souls of the trees."

The Chinese entertain the queer notion that the spirits of plants take on the form of humans or beasts. For example, they fancy that when a tree is felled the tree spirit makes its escape in the form of a blue bell.

In southern Fukin, woodsmen will not chop down large trees for fear the indwelling spirit may become angry and retaliate by sending disease and calamity. Especially respected are the green banyans of China, the largest trees to be found in that part of China. Travelers to the valley of the Nile are amazed to see magnificent sycamores standing like lone sentinels in the sandy soil. Why have they weathered time and the axe of man? Because the ancient Egyptians esteemed these trees divine, and paid them regular homage. They gave these lonely giants figs, raisins, etc. The spirit that animated these beautiful trees generally remained invisible, but sometimes he would show his head or even his whole body.

People in Congo set vessels containing palm-wine at the foot of certain trees for the trees to drink when thirsty.

In parts of China a man reckons his wealth in pigs, cattle, lambs and what have you. An African Chief complained recently that the cost of living had gone so high that he had to give 20 cows for a wife.

In the U.S.A. money is periodically washed and ironed. This helps it to last longer. While a coin will live in circulation many years, an ordinary bank note has a life
