SEAWAY WORKERS STRIKE JUNE 17

OTTAWA (CP)—St. Lawrence Seaway workers are set to strike at noon June 17 in what might be the first major tie-up of shipping in the seven-year history of the international waterway.

The strike date was announced Tuesday—the day after the workers voted overwhelmingly for strike action—and by afternoon two federal cabinet ministers met to discuss the question.
