

### Markers Planned

OTTAWA (CP)—Markers indicating latitude and longitude will be placed on the grounds of each provincial legislature and on Ottawa's Nepean Point during 1967. Surveyor-General Robert Thistlethwaite said here.

Called geodetic survey points by surveyors, the markers will be encased in concrete monuments. Plaques nearby in English and French will explain the points.

Mr. Thistlethwaite said the provincial governments will pay installation costs of the points, which usually indicate height above sea level as well as the other measurements.

He also said a marker and monument will be built at Whitehorse in the Yukon.

Each point will be connected to the other by a prices survey.

**Some Pensioners Pay Income Tax**

OTTAWA (CP)—Some old age pensioners will have to pay income tax when they begin drawing the \$30 monthly supplement proposed for those with no outside income beyond the universal \$75 monthly pension.

In his mini-budget Monday night Finance Minister Sharp left the basic income tax exemption unchanged at \$1,000, plus the \$100 standard deduction for charities available to all taxpayers.

Thus a pensioner aged 65 or 69 qualifying for the supplement will have an income of \$1,200 and be liable to tax on \$160 of it. On this he would pay \$17.00 in income tax plus \$6.40 for the old age pension levy.

At age 70, however, another \$600 deduction is available that would take such a pensioner off the tax rolls.

Officials said the number of pensioners in this taxable bracket would be small. The majority would have other exemptions.

**Cane-Maker Dies At 82**

LONDON (CP)—William G. Cox, 82, noted English cane-maker, died Monday at his workshop-home.

He was the son of Ben Cox, even better known as a cane-maker during the First World War. Canes made by father and son were carried by Canadian soldiers of two wars.

The firm of Ben Cox and Son, a business that specialized in custom-crafted walking sticks and umbrellas for a century, died with William Cox.

King George VI and other members of the royal family used canes and umbrellas from William Cox, who ran four retail stores and employed 30 craftsmen until the Second World War.

Paul Cox, Williams son and grandson of the firm's founder, said his father closed the family's last store about 12 years ago. Lately, he filled a diminishing number of special orders from a workshop in his suburban Ealing home.

Paul, a construction contractor, said the remnants of the business are being wound up.
