Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) - A general weakness hit stock market prices Wednesday, knocking most of the exchange indexes more than a point lower.

Volume totalled 5,081,000 shares as low-priced mining issues and western oils continued to attract wide interest. New Brunswick base metals joined the downward trend after a firm opening.

Western oils led the general losses, dropping almost two index points. Golds lost more than a point each while base metals lost slightly less than one index point.

A loss of more than \$1 in Gunbarren demonstrated the weakness in uranium. Brunswick and New Labrador base metals base metals lower with sharp losses.

Western oils losses ranged to 35 cents as Anglo-Canadian, Calvan, Bailey Selburn, Brantia, Canada Southern, Federated and Western Leaseholds slipped.

Base metals turned lower on losses in higher-priced issues as International Nickel and Hudson Bay slipped.

General losses in senior goods, junior producers, prospects and holding companies depressed the gold index.

The exchange's closing indexes showed golds down 1.11 at 82.77, base metals down .80 at 175.55 and western oils down 1.85 to 121.02.

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market was hard hit Wednesday by selling that arose over uncertainty surrounding the illness of Premier Stalin.

At the same time, a new thought on the Far East conflict was voiced by Gen. James Van Fleet when he told the House armed services committee that a Korean victory is possible without enlarging that war into a greater conflict.

All sections were lower-steels, rails, motors, aircrafts, coppers, chemicals, oils and the others. Movement was noted, scattered improvement was noted.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks declined \$1.10 and closed at \$133.40. The loss for the average was the greatest of the last month.

The industrial component of the average was down \$1.50, railroads down \$1.00, and utilities down 20 cents.

Volume stepped up to 2,010,000 shares.

Before the market opened, considerable nervousness was reported in Wall Street over the possible consequences to the world in the event of Stalin's death.

The London market virtually ignored the whole thing with the stock market firm at the close.

Fifty-four nations are members of the World Bank for Reconstruction and Development.
