NEW YORK (AP) - Closing on the heaviest volume of the year, the stock market fell by a whisker Wednesday to make an all-time high and profit taking increased in the final hour.

Volume mounted to 6,000,000 shares on Tuesday's \$370.97, and was the largest since last Dec. 5 when 6,200,000 shares changed hands.

Steele provided strong leadership early in the session and kept a fair part of their gain but other industrials later in their upward drive and profit taking increased in the final hour.

The Dow Jones industrial average kept a gain of 50 to close at 72.92, but was off 1/2 in its closing peak of 73.91 on Dec. 13, 1951.

It was a turbulent session with the ticker tape up and repeatedly.

The market was uncertain at the start but gradually moved upward on balance as stocks showed the way. At no time, however, was it a solid advance.

Losers spotted many important sections of the list even as the averages rose.

The Associated Press average of 49 stocks rose 2/3 to 279.7.

Among Canadian issues a traded Aluminum Ltd. fell 1/4 and Hudson Bay, Granby Mining gained 1/4, International Nickel 's and Walker-Goodman 's.

Prices were mixed on the American, Canadian and Marconell fell 1/4 and Fargo Oil 1/16. Molybdenum gained 1/16 and Procter 5/16.
