 LONDON (Reuters)—Britain's national health service cost \$58,000,000 (\$1,640,000,000) in the financial year ending March 31 last year, the ministry of health announced Thursday. This was about \$50,000,000 more than the year before.
 Some four-fifths of the money was provided by the government and the rest came mostly from the weekly compulsory pay deductions from all adult workers.

Strike Ties Up Halifax Project
HALIFAX (CP)—Work on the new Sir James Dunn science building at Dalhousie University halted Wednesday when carpenters, and laborers refused to cross picket lines set up by a plasterers' union.
 The plasterers, members of the Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' International Association (CLC), are not employed on the \$1,000,000 science building donated by Lady Dunn in memory of her industrialist husband.
