Five Escaped Convicts Captured

PUTNAM, Conn. (AP) — Five convicts who fled the Norfolk, Mass., prison colony Thursday night were recaptured Friday in a swift-moving manhunt that spanned the Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Connecticut state lines. Two hostages taken by the escapers—one a prison colony guard and the other a Pawtucket, R.I., civilian—were rescued unharmed. Richard Lavoie, 40, of Woonsocket, R.I., limping with a broken foot, was recaptured in a swamp in Pawtucket's west end. The others were retaken after their car, stolen in Pawtucket, crashed into a tree in Putnam. Russell Halliday, 26, of Cambridge, Mass., ringleader of the escape, and James L. Schworm, 31, of Malden, Mass., were taken by Connecticut state police at the crash scene. Later, William J. Couture, 40, of Taunton, Mass., and Martin F. Feeney, 38, of Boston were flushed from nearby woods.
