Picking dead fish eggs is as easy as telling sex of a chicken before it is hatched from the egg if one knows the how of it.

Only for the dead fish egg picker who braves the cold water, the "siphon coup", and the feeling that the whole world is made up of nothing but a mass of fragile fish eggs, the bearers of the rod and reel wouldn't be able to stroll to their favorite stream and lift out those speckled beauties.

There are more jobs to be done around a hatchery than the average person knows about. Many eggs die in the period of incubation. They become white with a fuzzy growth attached to the exterior. If these are not segregated from the rest of the fuzz, they spread to other eggs. This means that a whole fry of fish fruit can be lost in a short time.

A siphon with its rubber bulb looks like a big eyedropper. It's an important gadget around a hatchery however, because it's the tool used to remove the dead eggs.

A visit to some of our Island hatcheries and a talk with the men in charge of these plants will reveal many wonders of the fish world not known to the average John Henry or Mary Smith.

You may lift an eyebrow in surprise when I tell you that there is a cast system among the beasts and the birds, the same as there is among humans. If this were not so how does one account for a cardinal fighting its own reflection in a window; a barnyard fowl strutting about proudly, or sometimes going about with the "swells", with each chicken kept in its proper place by the blue bloods of the flock.

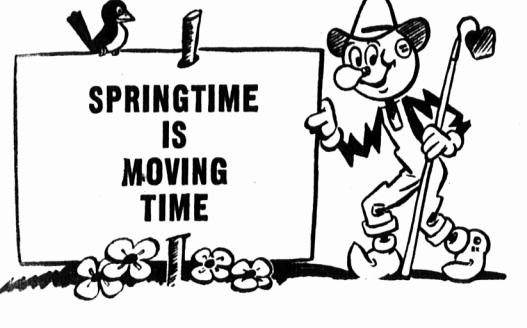
