I feel that my past work experience and my time spent here thus far qualifies me for the position of comptroller and that next week you will give me your support.



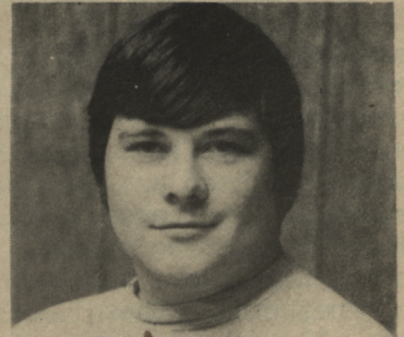
Billy Willis
