age joining Lake Huron and Lake Erie—drop 8 ft.
3. Niagara Falls which separates Lake Erie from Lake Ontario—drop, 336 feet.
4. The St. Lawrence River section which includes the International Rapids Section, the Lake Francis and the Soulanges Section and the Lachine section—where the drop is 225 feet.
5. Montreal to the sea—the portion which lies wholly in Canadian territory and in which there is a drop of 20 feet.

\* Spindle tuber is a virus disease of the potato which affects both the plants and the tubers. The symptoms vary with the variety and the environment under which the plant is grown. The most characteristic symptom is the formation of erect and slightly dwarfed plants that produce rough, elongated, and spindle-shaped tubers.
