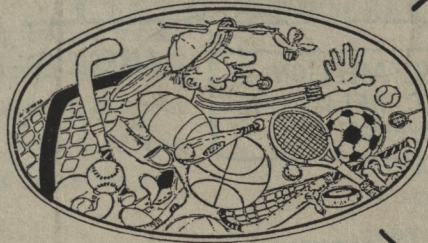

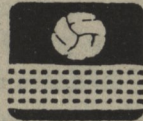

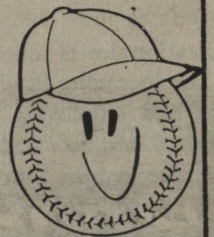

Games Appoints Artistic Director

Charlottetown - On April 4, Mr. Roger Perry, volunteer vice president of protocol and ceremonies for the 1991 Canada Games, announced the appointment of Jacques Lemay as Artistic Director/Choreographer for the opening and closing ceremonies of the games.

Mr. Lemay brings with him a tremendous wealth of experience, having served as artistic director of opening ceremonies of the 1988 Calgary Winter Olympics, opening and closing ceremonies of the 1989 Canada Summer Games in Saskatoon, and the highly acclaimed Canada Heritage Festival Productions.

Islanders are certainly familiar with Mr. Lemay's work. Beginning his professional career as a performer, Mr. Lemay is a veteran with the Charlottetown Festival, appearing in Anne, Belinda, and Korndorg 1582, as well as three years with Les Feux Follets, including the National Tour in 1974.

Most recently, Mr. Lemay choreographed the adaptation of Anne of Green Gables performed at the Confederation Centre of the Arts last fall by the royal Winnipeg Ballet.

Mr. Lemay arrives in Charlottetown today for the first time as artistic director of opening/closing ceremonies for the 1991 games.

While in Charlottetown, he will be meeting with Gary Craswell, volunteer producer of opening/closing ceremonies, and will be putting out a call for talent.

The nationally televised opening and closing ceremonies are an exciting time for all participants, spectators, and viewers and allows Prince Edward Island to show off our talent to the rest of the country.
