FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE PLEDGE

The following is the text of
the Florence Nightingale Pledge
which all nurses take upon enter-
ing the profession.

I solemnly pledge myself be-
fore God and in the presence of
this assembly to pass my life in
purity and to practise my profes-
sion faithfully. I will abstain
from whatever is deleterious and

mischievous and will not take or
knowingly administer any harm-
ful drug. I will do all in my
power to elevate the standard of
my profession and will hold in
confidence all personal matters
committed to my keeping, and all
family affairs coming to my
knowledge in the practise of my
calling. With loyalty will I en-
deavour to aid the physician in
his work and devote myself to
the welfare of those committed
to my care.

this time, under her direction, the
Brocton School of Nursing was or-
ganized. Under her direction and
guidance progress was made and
new buildings were added and
equipped and a home for nurses
built. While at this hospital she
became interested, with a group
of other members of the nursing
profession, in forming a corpora-
tion under the name of the Mas-
sachusetts State Nurses Associa-
tion.

Miss Beattie after this went
abroad with a group of senior
nurses and visited most of the im-
portant hospitals in Europe, spend-
ing several months on the tour.
She came home to Prince Ed-
ward Island after that for a time
but her active nature prompted
her to be going and she went out
on the important mission of re-
organizing hospitals.

It was during a rest period in
her native town of Summerside
in 1912 that she organized a school
for nurses and the Prince County
Hospital which institution had
been made possible through the
beneficence of the late Thomas E.
Ramsay. In 1929 she retired from
active hospital work and then went
to the United States and took a
four years course at Boston Uni-
versity in religious art in which
she was profoundly interested.
About 1941 she returned to Sum-
merside to spend the remainder of
her life here.
