

Rail Laying Starts On New N.B. Line

MONCTON (CP) — Rail laying started on the new, 23-mile line from Bariboug, north of New Brunswick, to the Health Steele mine, R. G. Hayes, vice-president and general manager of the Canadian National Railways' Atlantic region, announced in an address here Monday.

"It is significant that this is the first new railway to be built in the Maritimes for more than 40 years, apart from spurs and sidings," he said. "It is evident, too, that the CNR, in common with the government and other interested parties, regards the New Brunswick mining potential as something of great and lasting value."

Further Change Announced In Health Insurance Scheme

OTTAWA (CP) — The federal and provincial governments may be sharing Canadians' hospital bills—at least in some provinces—sooner than previously expected. Health Minister Martin disclosed Monday night that the federal government is willing to share half the cost of standard ward hospital care and diagnostic services once five provinces have signed agreements with Ottawa and passed enabling legislation. This was seen as a major federal concession. Originally, the federal unit was not to be forthcoming until at least six provinces representing at least half Canada's population had plans in operation. The latest federal move was uncovered at the end of a day of Commons debate on a government resolution introducing a bill to enable federal participation in the plan. The resolution was approved and the bill introduced with unanimous House approval. CHANGES REJECTED But both the Progressive Conservatives and the CCF first criticized the government's plan and suggested changes in it. Dr. William Blair (PC-Lanark) proposed an amendment to the resolution providing for federal sharing of the scheme's cost with any province that accepted. Stanley Knowles (CCF-Winnipeg North Centre) said his party supports the Conservative stand. But he added that the CCF believes there should be a complete health plan. The government's hospital plan did not go far enough: It should be paid 80 per cent by Ottawa and include costs of treatment in mental and tuberculosis hospitals. The bill covering the national hospital insurance scheme proposes that federal-provincial hospital insurance cover just about every medical cost in a hospital but the doctor's bill. Coverage would extend to in-patient and out-patient facilities in general hospitals, but not TB sanatoria, mental institutions or nursing homes, infirmaries or homes for the aged. Treatment would include necessary nursing services; laboratory, radiological and other diagnostic services; use of operating and case rooms and anaesthetic facilities and supplies; routine surgi-

Yard Operations Are "Different"

OTTAWA (CP)—A CPR engineer Monday testified before the Kellock royal commission investigating the need for firemen in diesel freight and yard service, that firemen contribute nothing but "company" for the engineer. George Mountstevon of Toronto, a CPR engineer for 11 years and former fireman in freight, passenger and yard service since 1920, said he relied on the fireman only for "company" and perhaps "to give me a drink of water."

He said ground crew signals are given directly to the engineer. He did not need a fireman for passing signals because "there is nothing he can observe that I can't see."

D. B. Lewis, counsel for the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Engineers, asked the witness what difference he saw between a freight engine operated only by an engineer and a yard diesel with only one man in the cab.

Mountstevon replied that yard operations are "altogether different" from main line service when flagging protection must be arranged and other duties carried out.

Turn Down Fish Liver Program

DARTMOUTH, N.S. (CP)—The Dartmouth board of school commissioners Monday rejected a request from the Notting Park Home and School Association which sought approval for a program of providing fish liver capsules for school pupils.

"There is always the danger of pupils being coerced into a program for which they have no desire," Board Chairman Gordon Hart said in commenting on the association's proposal. Commissioner Creed Hollis, who was in favor of the program, said it had been approved by the medical health officer and carried out on a non-compulsory basis.

Opposing the move commissioner E. A. Payzant said "I don't want any school board to determine what my child takes that's my responsibility."

A Seattle reader calls my attention to this hand which came up in the recently held Pacific Northwest Regional tournament. He makes no claim anyone made six spades and, in fact, admits he spotted the opportunity to make the spectacular play required to bring home the slam. He is still busy kicking himself for having bobbed his chances to be a hero.

I must say in all fairness, one seldom sees a hand where it is so easy for declarer to slip and fracture his contract.

The bidding should have followed the other channels, both six notrump and six clubs being laid down, but our correspondent found himself in six spades.

The ace of hearts was opened and a heart continued, South discarding the setting trick, but he never could have gotten it if declarer had trumped the heart instead of taking a useless card.

Suppose South ruffs the heart and plays A-K of spades, learning the trump situation. His only chance then is to establish a trump coup. Declarer therefore plays three rounds of clubs, trumping the third one. (East, of course, does not ruff the third club, but discards a diamond.)

South now leads a diamond to the queen and ruffs another club. East pitching another diamond. Declarer then plays a diamond to the king and the position is: Dummy leads the ten of clubs, and East is a dead pigeon.

South now leads the king of hearts at trick two this position cannot be reached. Try it and see.

Investigate Sunday Business At Falls

TORONTO (IP)—Rev. A. S. McGrath, secretary of the Lord's Day Alliance, said Monday the Alliance finds it difficult to understand why businesses operating on Sunday in the Niagara Falls area have not been investigated until now.

He said the alliance has complained of Sunday operators in the area for many years and had asked authorities to investigate them several years ago.

Assistant crown attorney Donald Scott announced Sunday in Niagara Falls that an investigation into a complaint by the Alliance was almost complete.

A report on about 80 businesses allegedly operating on Sundays will be sent to the attorney-general's department "sometime this week," he said, accompanied by a request for leave to prosecute.
