Volume for the day increased to 4,520,000 shares from 4,270,000 Thursday.

RCA, which declared a 10-per-cent stock dividend and a 10-per-cent special dividend, was most active, up 1 1/4 to 31,700 shares.

United Aircraft advanced more than a point and General Dynamics gained half a point.

Prices on the American Exchange were mixed. Volatility edged up a word to 1,510,000 shares from 1,490,000 Thursday.
