Sickness Keeps Plante Out Of Tonight's Game

MONTREAL (CP)—Goalie Jacques Plante of Montreal was missing Tuesday night when the National Hockey League club left for New York and tonight's game with the Rangers.

Plante suffered an acute bronchial attack after a practice session at the forum and was taken to hospital for diagnosis of a fever.

Gerry McNeil of Montreal Royals, regular goalkeeper for the Habs for four years prior to the 1954-55 season, will replace Plante for the Rangers game.

When word of Plante's illness reached coach Toe Blake, McNeil was pulled from a train minutes before it left for Chicoutimi, Que., where the Royals played the Quebecers Tuesday night in a Quebec Hockey League fixture.
