TO STOP MOTOR SLAUGHTER.

BERLIN, May 3.—The Government introduced into the Reichstag a few days ago a bill obliging automobilists to pay life annuities to those dependent on persons killed by their motor cars or to persons permanently injured by such accidents, amounting to be assessed by the courts, and holding owners of machines and not chauffeurs to be responsible. The measure was referred to a committee.
