TORONTO (CP) The stock market scored a modest advance Monday with strength in a few divisions lifting the average level of prices.

The refining oils and pipelines on the whole individual industrials were sought out rather than groups. Western oils advanced on fractional gains in the senior group. Mines were the only decidedly weak division, but a few standouts gained the list.

Accumulated weekend orders helped boost the volume to 7,838,000 shares from just over 7,000,000 Friday.

International Paper, with expansion planned, turned in the best individual performance with an \$8.50 jump to a high of \$142.50. International Utilities, at a high of \$50, and Trans-Prarie Pipeline, at \$20.50, each climbed \$2.50. Cannon Westinghouse advanced \$2 to \$40.

Motors were weaker with Chrysler off 1.75 and Ford Motor down \$1.50. Weston and Universal Products also slipped \$1.50. Algoma, Building Products, Asbestos, International Metal A and Bank of Montreal move of a point.

Dullness in senior mines was partly offset by small fractional gains by International Nickel, Kerr Addison and Hudson Bay. One slipped after hitting a new peak of \$98.25, a gain of \$1.87. Chibougamau Explorers gained 27 cents at \$1.50 and New Manitoba added 19 at \$1.25. Also advanced were Little Long Lac, Temagami, Arcadia, Preston East Dome and Diadem.

MELBOURNE (Reuters)—Thousands of Australians today were refusing to accept £5 notes in a "fever fever" brought about by circulation of expertly-counterfeited currency.

PLAN MASS ONSLAUGHT Newspapers have reported the counterfeiters planned to put the bills into circulation in mass proportions, particularly at the race tracks on Saturdays.

A reward of £1,000 has been offered by the Commonwealth Bank for information leading to the discovery of the forgers.

Nearly all the fake bills have been found in Victoria state and suspicion was touched off when banks started receiving the fake bills singly or in pairs a few weeks ago. So far, more than £1,000 worth of the counterfeiters have been discovered, and several hundred thousand pounds worth have been reported to be in existence.

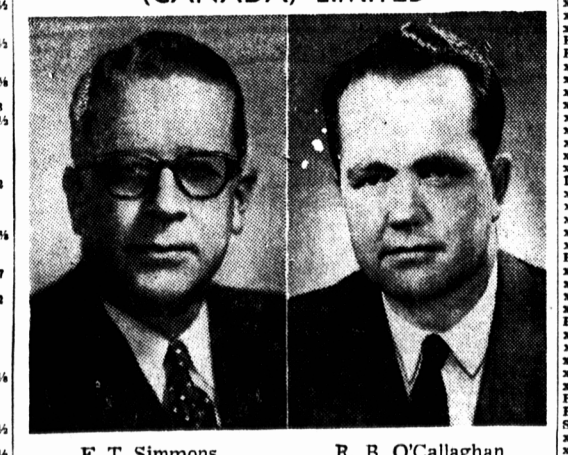

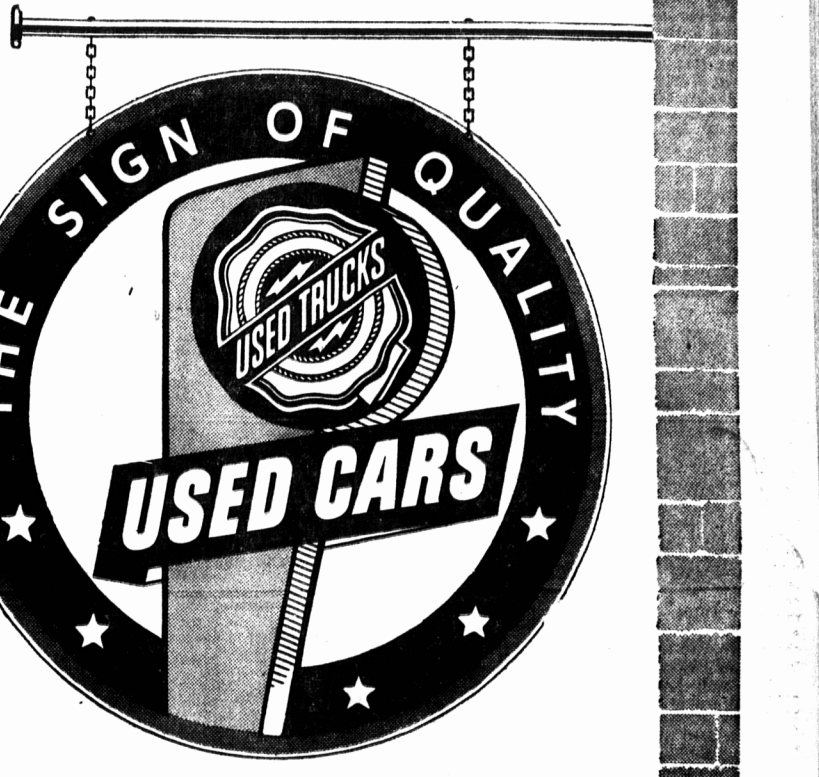
