Strange But True

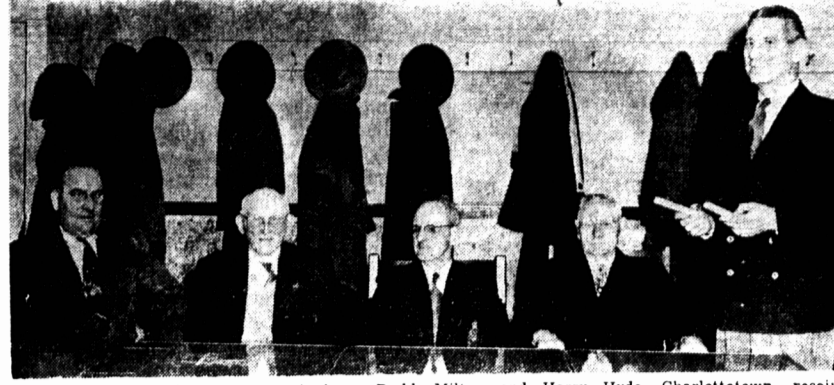

Commission To Study Insanity Plea In Code

OTTAWA, (CP) - Chief Justice J. C. McRuer of Ontario will head a five-member royal commission to study possible changes in the criminal code dealing with the defence of insanity.

Justice Minister Garson announced the members of the commission in the Commons Wednesday. The other four: Dr. Gustave Desrochers of St. Michel Hospital and Laval University, Quebec city; Judge Helen Kinnear, judge of Haldimand county court, Ontario; Dr. Robert Jones, professor of psychiatry at Dalhousie University, Halifax, and Joseph Harris of Winnipeg, president of the Great West Life Assurance Company.

Islander Is Victim Of Traffic Accident

The following is a clipping from the Brantford Expositor: "Keith Allison Wagner, 25, of 40 Pearl Street, died early Feb. 24, in the Norfolk General Hospital, at Simcoe from injuries he received Saturday night in a traffic accident near Delhi.
