Common Loon - 4 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Red-throated Loon - 2 at East Point on Oct. 24 (GH).

Northern Gannet - 3 at Basin Head on Oct. 12 (LA); at least 150 (95% adult) in one half hour period rounding East Point heading south on Oct. 24, but none a half hour later at North Lake (GH).

Great Cormorant - 100 at Cape Tryon colony on Oct. 3 (WEC); 50-60 (mostly greater's) at East Point on Oct. 24 (GH).

Double-crested Cormorant - 20 at Cape Tryon colony on Oct. 3 (WEC).

Canada Goose - 350 off Cape Tryon on Oct. 3 (WEC); 12 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Snow Goose - 4 white phase with Canada's off Cape Tryon on Oct. 3 (WEC); 1 blue phase at Moore's Sanctuary on Oct. 15 (FRC).

Black Duck - 60 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC); 350 at Hillsborough Bridge on Oct. 16 (WEC).

Blue-winged Teal - 50 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Oldsquaw - 1 at North Rustico on Oct. 3 (WEC); 13 at East Point on Oct. 24 (GH).

Common Eider - 60 at Cape Tryon on Oct. 3 (WEC); 6-8 at North Cape on Oct. 6 (AB, SM); more than 100 at East Point on Oct. 24 (GH).

Goshawk - 1 immature in Alberton on Sept. 20 (GM).

Sharp-shinned Hawk - 1 at Officer's Pond in Suffolk on Oct. 2 (FRC, MLM).

Red-tailed Hawk - 1 adult at Vernon River on Sept. 23 (MLM).

Bald Eagle - 1 at Morell River on Oct. 4 (GK).

Marsh Hawk - 2 at Cape Tryon on Oct. 3 and 2 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC); 1 at East Point on Oct. 4 (DLC); 1 male at Burton on Oct. 12 (GM).

American Kestrel - 1 in Caledonia on Oct. 2 and 1 at Cape Tryon on Oct. 3 (WEC); 1 at Lyndale in October (JW); 1 at Kildare on Oct. 12 (GM).

Ruffed Grouse - 1 drumming at Green Gables House on Oct. 6 (AL).

Gray Partridge - 3 covies at East Point on Oct. 4 (DLC).

Semipalmated Plover - 4 at North Rustico on Oct. 3 and 5 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Black-bellied Plover - 5 at North Rustico on Oct. 3 and 4 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

White-rumped Sandpiper - 6 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Semipalmated Sandpiper - 2 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Sanderling - 25 at North Rustico on Oct. 3 and 50 at Greenwich on Oct. 4 (WEC).

Iceland Gull - 1 at North Lake on Oct. 24 (GH).

Great Black-backed Gull - a flock of 100 at East Point plus good numbers at North Lake on Oct. 24 (GH).

Herring Gull - a flock of 50 at East Point plus lots at North Lake on Oct. 24 (GH).
