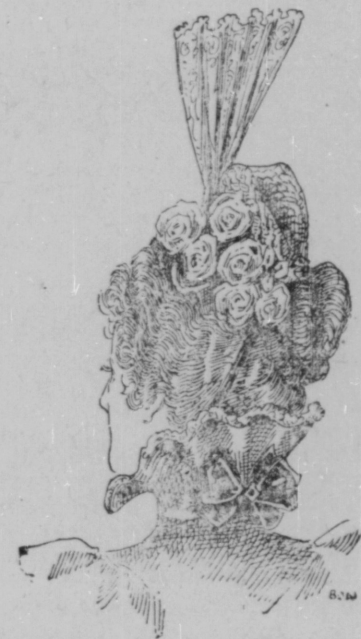

NOTES AND COMMENTS.

Gold is said to be plentiful in Mississippi, and it is said that 25 per cent of the American volunteers will engage in the mining industry after the rebellion has been quelled, and they get their discharge.

Parliamentary business at Ottawa has progressed so slowly that the Senate is compelled to adjourn for the want of something to do. According to the latest advices the Government now propose to adjourn till the 1st of June, a controversial character and close the session as soon as possible. So far the Liberal leaders in Parliament have not shown an amazing capacity for business.

—An Ottawa despatch reports that in consequence of the judgment delivered by the Judicial committee of the Privy Council on May 26, 1898, with reference to the respective jurisdictions of the Dominion of Canada and the provinces thereof on the subject of the coast and inland fisheries, the Minister of Marine and Fisheries has dispensed with the services of overseers and fishery officers appointed in the province of Quebec, inasmuch as the administration of the laws and regulations to be made for the protection and control of fisheries in their districts, will rest chiefly, if not solely, in the hands of officers to be appointed by the Provincial Government, and the revenue derived from licenses to fish in the said districts will be received by the Provincial Government of Quebec. The services fifty-five Dominion employees are consequently dispensed with, and the expense of protecting the inland fisheries of Quebec is thrown upon the Provincial Government.

Kruger's Boast.

PRITONIA, April 30—In the course of his speech at the opening of the Volksraad, President Kruger announced that the Transvaal was now the largest gold producing country in the world. He said the output in 1898 was £ 6,240,630, being an increase of £4,586,905 over the output of the previous year.
