

Saloons Depend Upon Drunkards.

The cost of alcoholic liquors in the United States is \$900,000,000 annually. In 1883 there were 206,970 liquor dealers and manufacturers, and the capital is estimated at \$1,000,000,000. The saloons could not exist upon the patronage of moderate drinkers. The maintenance of these places depends upon the drunkard. Intemperance is often an intangible quantity. The sufferer himself is not conscious of its ravages. Every morning the police calendar is black with the names of men and women arrested for drunkenness. The Bureau of Labor of Boston, after a careful investigation, declares that eighty-four per cent. of all crime is the direct or indirect fruit of alcohol. All studies of American political economy bring the conclusion that poverty would scarcely exist were it not for drink.—*Prairie Farmer.*

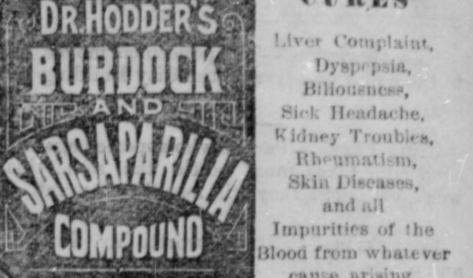
