Flax and rye led price increases: October and December flax scored maximum gains which were all but held at the close. Some buying was for industrial account and local interests. Offerings were light. Rye scored moderate gains. There were irregular offerings and buying sales in oats and barley. October and December barley scored advances. A major factor in the market was unfavorable weather in the prairie grain belt. No overnight export loadings were reported. Prices for class two and I W. A. wheat were unchanged.
