By ALTON L. BLAKESLEE NEW YORK (AP)—Russia will give Americans a grandstand seat to see the Soviet man-made moons sent up to explore space, but few Russians are likely to see the American-made moons.

Many Americans may see the moons of both sides. Soviet citizens will have only their own to look for.
