A STITCH IN TIME.

Against the Kaiser.

BERLIN, April 26.—Kaiser Wilhelm's pet schemes in the Reichstag, one providing for the construction of a big Rhine-Elbe canal and the other providing for radical reform of Germany's prison system will meet with woeful defeat, judging from the present outlook.

The canal bill, on which the Kaiser spent so much time and labor during his journey in the Province of Hanover last fall, is about to be rejected by the Reichstag. But a small minority is in favour of vast expenditures on industrial improvements within the boundaries of the Fatherland.

As to the prison reform bill, but few Reichstag members look with favour upon it. It is learned from an authentic source that the Government will not present it in the present session.

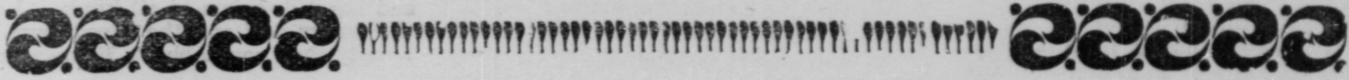

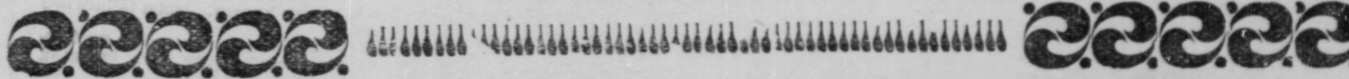
