Snowy Owl - 1 Nov. 15 at Brackley dunes (MR) and 1 Nov. 19 at Covehead Harbour marsh (MR, BB, LK); 1 on Watts Road on Dec. 2 (YB, GF)

Northern Flicker - 1 working barn shingles at DeSable on Dec. 2 (BP)

Red-bellied Woodpecker - 1 female at DeSable on Nov. 8 at 9:50 a.m. (GW); 1 at Crapaud in August (JK); 1 at Stanley Bridge on Nov. 28 (WM, RC with photographs); male and female at Birch Hill (MWM)

Blue Jay - 40 to 50+ at Indian River feeder from mid-Nov. to Dec. 7 (TC)

Common Raven - a white-rumped and -tailed raven was seen on Oct. 6 in the Strathgartney/St. Catherine's area (EC)

Red-breasted Nuthatch - 2 at Indian River Feeder in mid-Nov. (TC)

Wren sp. - late Nov. in barn at Hazelgrove (LS)

Brown Creeper - 1 at Bunbury the week of Nov. 4 (R&JT)

Yellow-rumped Warblers - 1 on feeder at Sharam Point on Oct. 20 - Nov. 2 (P&AW); 3 at Rustico Island on Nov. 15 (RC)

Bay-breasted Warbler - immature male at Indian River feeder on Dec. 7 (TC)

Blackpoll Warbler - 2 on Sept. 24 on Appin Road (EC)

Red-winged Blackbird - 1 at Bunbury feeder the week of Nov. 5 (R&JT); 1 at Indian River feeder in mid-Nov. (TC); 1 at DeSable on Nov. 24 (BP); 2 Dec 10 at South Lake (FS)

Common Grackle - 1 at Indian River feeder in mid-Nov. (TC)

Brown-headed Cowbird - 11 at DeSable on Nov. 24 and 45 on Dec. 8 (BP)

Blackbirds - large mixed flocks at Donagh in mid- to late-October (JDM)

Western Kingbird - 1 at China Point on Dec. 14 (JH)

Northern Oriole - 1 struck DeSable window on October 25 (RA)

Evening Grosbeak - partial albino (white head) one at Mt. Albion Nov. 11 (LM); 6 to 8 at Indian River feeder in early Dec. (TC)

Pine Grosbeak - 1 immature male on ground in Brookvale Demonstration Woodlot on Nov. 1 (PF)

American Tree Sparrow - 2 on Nov. 8 and 6 on Nov. 21 at Sleepy Hollow (EC)

White-crowned Sparrow - 1 at Mount Albion from Nov. 8 - 11 (LM); 1 at Bunbury feeder the week of Nov. 4 (R&JT)

White-throated Sparrow - 1 at Bunbury feeder Nov 4 - 12 (R&JT)

Fox Sparrow - last one seen on Nov. 5 at Bunbury feeder (R&JT)

Song Sparrow - 4 at Sleepy Hollow on Nov. 8 (EC)

Snow Bunting - 60 at Rustico Island on Nov. 14; 40 at Brackley on Nov. 28 & 65 at Long Pond on Nov. 28 (RC); at Blooming Pt on Nov. 29 (GK)
