

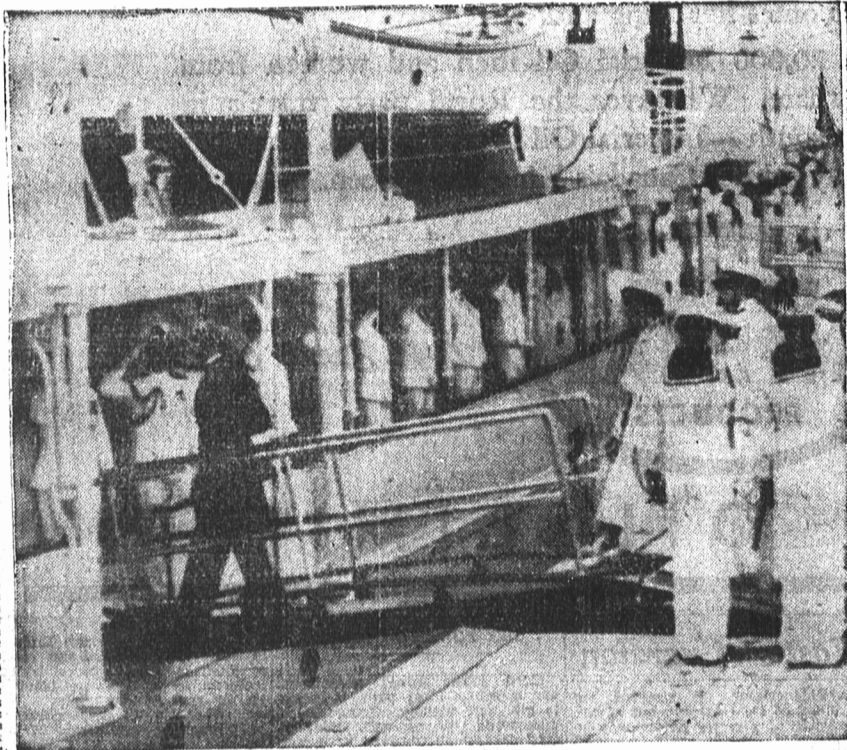

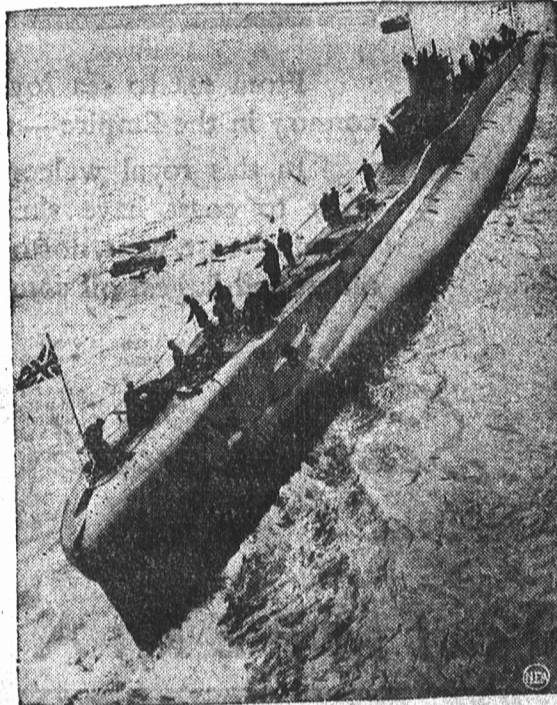
Leah Burkett of Linden, M. D., presents to the Queen and King the medal she won for her services to the Girl Scouts.

King George King of England is seen boarding the yacht.



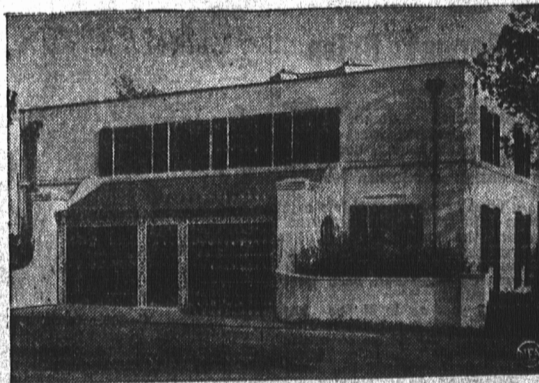
The New British submarine Trident, above, is a sister ship and virtual replica of the Thetis, which sank off Liverpool, England, with more than 70 aboard.
