MCCARTHY'S MOTION.

No one can now say that the Government of Sir Mackenzie Bowell do not enjoy the confidence of a large majority in Parliament. Upon the first non-confidence motion their majority was thirty-four; upon the next there was an increased majority of forty-four; and upon the third and last there was no vote against them, except the mover and seconder.

The excitement in the House of Commons is about over. The Opposition have shot their last bolt, and it has gone wide of the mark.

Your columns have already chronicled the defeat of the motions of Mr. Laurier to adjourn the House and prevent the progress of business.

Expectation, yesterday, was on tiptoe for the word had been passed around that Mr. Laurier was to make the greatest speech of his life on the Manitoba School question.

Mr. Laurier was in good form, spoke glittering generalities as he alone can handle them; and evoked the hearty applause of his supporters; but when his policy and that of his party was looked for it was found wanting.

The debate was continued by Messrs. Tarte, Onimet, Dupont, Girouard and Bellefleur, and when the vote was taken at 2:30 a. m., (Tuesday) the amendment of the proposition was defeated by 44.

Prorogation is expected this week but the day is not settled. This afternoon Mr. McCarthy brings up his resolution when both sides must vote for or against the principle of separate schools.

Davies, Yeo, McLean and others are leaving for P. E. Island this week. Hon. D. Ferguson returned from Colorado on Monday. His name is mentioned in the list of the vacant portfolios.
