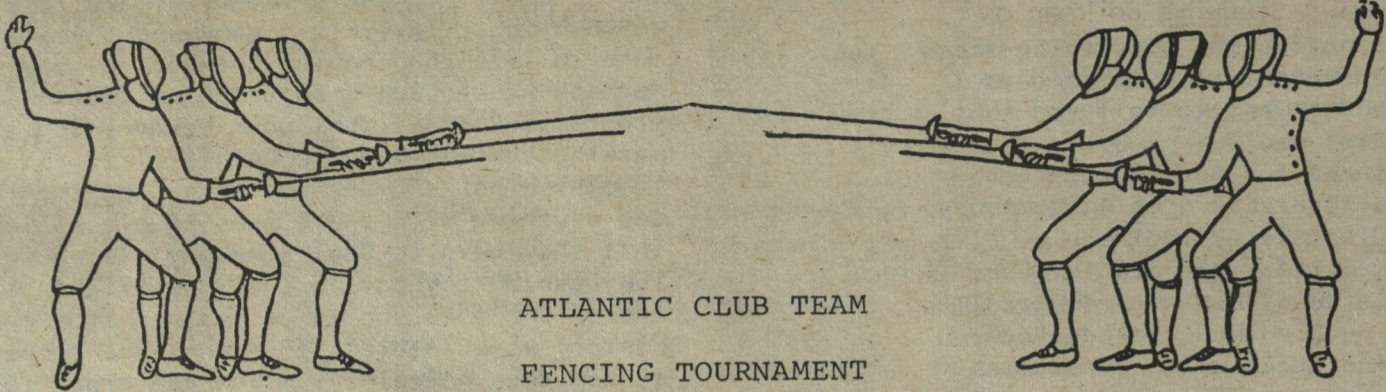


# FENCING TOURNAMENT SCHEDULED
