## IN MEMORIAM

### GORDON M. DIXON

The sudden passing of Gordon Matthew Dixon, as the result of a car accident early Sunday morning, July 6, 1958, came as a great shock to his many relatives and friends.

Gordon was the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. John H.B. Dixon of Dixon's Mills, DeSable. He was in his thirty-first year. Besides his parents, he leaves to mourn their great loss two sisters and one brother: Dorothy (Mrs. George C. Bicknell) of Fort William, Ontario; Marjorie (Mrs. Wyman J. Faulkner) of Dedham, Mass.; and MacKenzie K. Dixon of DeSable; as well as a nephew and five nieces. A sister, Gladys, died in infancy.

He was a skilful and progressive farmer, and the untimely ending of a life which showed such great promise is a distinct loss to the various communities which knew him so well. He possessed a most pleasing personality, kind and loving in the home, considerate and helpful to friends and neighbors.
