IN MEMORIAM

Stanford Campbell, Machineer, living at 233 N. Third Street, San Jose, Calif., died in a Hospital here Friday, Nov. 28th., following a lengthy illness. He was 69 years of age. KATHLEEN McNALLY There passed peacefully away at City Hospital in the early hours of Sunday morning, November 30th., Miss Kathleen McNally of Charlottetown.
