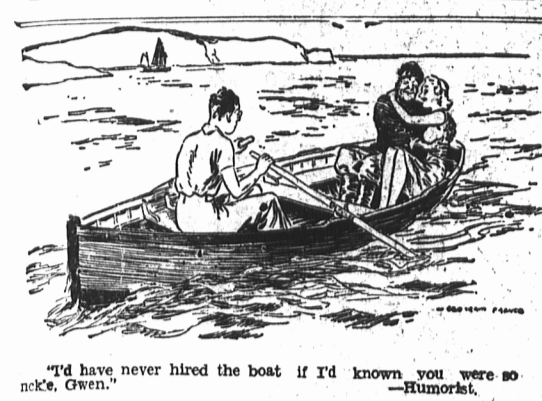

MONTREAL, Aug. 7 (CP)—Steadiness marked butter, cheese and potato prices on open produce markets here today, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. In quiet egg trading, prices eased a bit while receipts were light and demand slow. Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 23 1-2-23 cents a pound and solids for 22-22 1-2. Western butter delivered in Montreal was unquoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 21 1-2. Ontario white and colored cheese were both quoted at 11 cents. Quebec white was quoted at 10 5-8 and colored at 10 3-4. Graded egg shipments in used free cases sold at 28-28 1-2 cents a dozen for A-large, 26-26 1-2 for A-medium, 19 1-2-20 for B-large and 14 1-2-15 for C. Potatoes: Quebec new crop No. 1 75's 75-70; Quebec new crop No. 2 75's 65-70. MONTREAL, Aug. 7 (CP)—Receipts on today's Montreal livestock market were 809 cattle, 1,241 calves, 1,253 sheep, 1,087 hogs. Cattle prices were 25 cents or more higher. Calves were up to 25 cents higher. Lambs and hogs were easier. Cattle sales were active at prices 25 cents or more higher than last week's levels. Good steers made \$6.50 to \$7.00, medium steers were \$5.50 to \$6.00. Good heifers made \$5.50 with a top of \$5.25, medium \$4.00 to \$4.50, medium \$4.50 to \$5.25, to \$4.50 and common \$3.00 to \$3-75. Canners and cutters brought \$2.25 to \$2.75. Calves were in good demand at prices steady to 25 cents higher. Good quality veals made \$7 to \$7-50, with tops up to \$8 and with medium kinds around \$6.50. Common light veals sold down to \$5.
