

War Of Roses Still Rages In The Hearts Of Many

LONDON (CP)—The Wars of the Roses, to most Britons a blurred episode in their medieval past, rages still in some Yorkist and Lancastrian breasts.

Sunday is the 80th anniversary of the Battle of Bosworth Field, which closed 30 years of civil strife by putting the victorious Lancastrian Harry Tudor on the throne as Henry VII in place of the Yorkist Richard "the Lionheart" for a horse's tail, who died on the Leicestershire battlefield.

The contemporary champions of the houses of York and Lancaster have seized upon the anniversary as an occasion to flourish their standards again, the Bosworth Society proclaiming the greatness of Henry Tudor and the rival Fellowship of the White Boar defending the name of Richard of York.

Brian Evans of Aberlery, Wales—Harry Tudor had a Lancastrian mother but a Welsh father—extended a somewhat prickly olive branch on behalf of the Bosworth Society, which he heads.

"On the eve of the Battle of Bosworth," Evans says in a letter to The Times, "may I appeal for a complete cessation of hostilities in the Wars of the Roses?"

But the condition for a truce put to the White Boars is tantamount to a demand for the surrender of the Yorkists all over again.

The White Boars—they take their name from Richard III's emblem—cherish an obelisk on Bosworth Field that commemorates their hero's death. An inscription on the obelisk de-

Prominent Newspaperman Peter Inglis Dies Aged 50

VANCOUVER (CP)—Peter Inglis, 50, a prominent reporter and editor in Canada and abroad for 20 years, died Monday after a lengthy illness.

Mr. Inglis was most recently editor of the Vancouver Times which ceased publication Aug. 6 after less than a year in the Vancouver daily field.

He had been fighting cancer for several months.

He was best known as a correspondent from 1946 to 1948 in Washington, from 1948 to 1951 in London and Europe and from 1951 to 1953 in Ottawa.

Son of a newspaper man, Capt. T. B. Inglis, who was killed in action at Cambrai in 1918 during the First World War, Mr. Inglis was born in Victoria and educated in France and at Cheltenham College in England.

He entered newspaper work as a reporter with the Victoria Times in 1933, moved to Vancouver in 1939 with the old News-Herald, and in 1940 went to the Vancouver Province.

He was an RCAF pilot and instructor from 1943 to 1945, then returned to the Province.

He was with the Hamilton Spectator from 1953 to 1955, returned again to the Province as associate editor in 1955, and spent 1960 with the Vancouver Sun.

He left the newspaper field late in 1960 for public relations work in Winnipeg, and in 1961 joined the Montreal Star as as-

sociate editor, a position he held until he came to the Vancouver Times when it started publication in September, 1964.

Mr. Inglis is survived by his wife Margaret, a daughter Elizabeth in Montreal, and a son, John, at home.

Funeral arrangements have not been announced.

Trade Surplus Is Smallest Since Late '62

OTTAWA (CP)—Final official figures for foreign trade in the first quarter of 1964 showed a trade balance in Canada's favor of \$9,700,000, the smallest since the country began running surpluses in the last half of 1962.

The bureau of statistics said imports were valued at \$1,840,

000,000, down slightly from the preliminary figures reported by the bureau in May. This was an 11.3-per-cent increase in imports from the first three months of 1964.

Exports were valued at \$1,850,000,000 in the first quarter of 1964, compared with \$1,783,700,000 in the first quarter of last year. The trade balance was \$129,100,000 in Canada's favor in the first three months of 1964.

Work started, however, on a larger number of new single detached houses.

The Crown-owned housing authority said construction started on 13,700 housing units in urban centres of 5,000 population and over. This was down 3.5 per cent from housing starts in July, 1964. It covered a 12.9-per-cent reduction in apartment dwelling units and an 8.5-per-cent increase in single houses.

CMHC said that when seasonal factors were taken into account, the pace of construction starts in July represented an annual rate of 135,700 housing units. This was down sharply from the June rate of 165,700, but the corporation said the June rate was exceptionally high.
