**Hold Disaster Services Meeting At Montague**

A Red Cross Disaster Services meeting was held in the Legion Hall, Montague, last night, with the chairman, Judge J. S. DesRoches presiding. Present at the meeting were Mr. Gordon MacDonald, provincial chairman, and Miss I. Arsenault, provincial commissioner Red Cross.

Mr. MacDonald explained that the purpose of the Red Cross Disaster Services was to help those in need when a disaster occurs. He classified two types, minor and major, and said that although they have dealt with only minor ones so far, they are gearing the organization to a major disaster. He stated that in the case of a fire where a family's home and belongings are wiped out, the Red Cross can be called in for emergency service to provide clothing, food, etc., thereby assisting the people over the emergency forty-eight hour period.
