HALIFAX (CP) — A single-engine Piper Cub aircraft reported missing Wednesday with two men on board on a 150-mile flight from the Maritimes Islands to St. John's, Nfld. has turned up safely in Cartwright, Labrador, an RCMP Search and Rescue spokesman said yesterday.

The plane, piloted by Robert McIlwaine of Caprad, P.E.I. was on a seal spotting mission for a group of seal hunters on the Magdalen Islands. The passenger was Glen Matthews, a seal hunter from Alberton, P.E.I.

Island Native Dies In Ont.

Friends throughout the province will regret to learn of the death of Rev. R. Claire Wright in the Victoria Hospital, London, Ont., where he had undergone surgery.

Mr. Wright was a son of the late George and Mary Truman Wright of Sarnia, P.E.I., where he was born in 1892. He was educated at Sarnia school, Prince of Wales College, St. Allison University and Hill Divinity Hall.

Following his ordination in 1927 he went to Japan as a United Church missionary. He returned to Canada before the outbreak of war with Japan. He served on several churches in Ontario and was in Wardville when he became ill.

While in Japan he married Grace Norman, daughter of Dr. and Mrs. Dan Norman, also missionaries in Japan.

Left to mourn are his wife, one daughter, St. Catharines, at university in Toronto, two sons, Edgar with the Toronto board of educational research and William, a student at Emmanuel College Toronto, two sisters, Mrs. Elliott Wright of Summerside; Eliza, Mrs. George Roberts of Vancouver, Wablen of Sarnia and Lewis, of West Summerside, B.C.
