Mr. and Mrs. Eldon Stewart and three children of N.S. are holidaying with Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Stewart, Red Point.

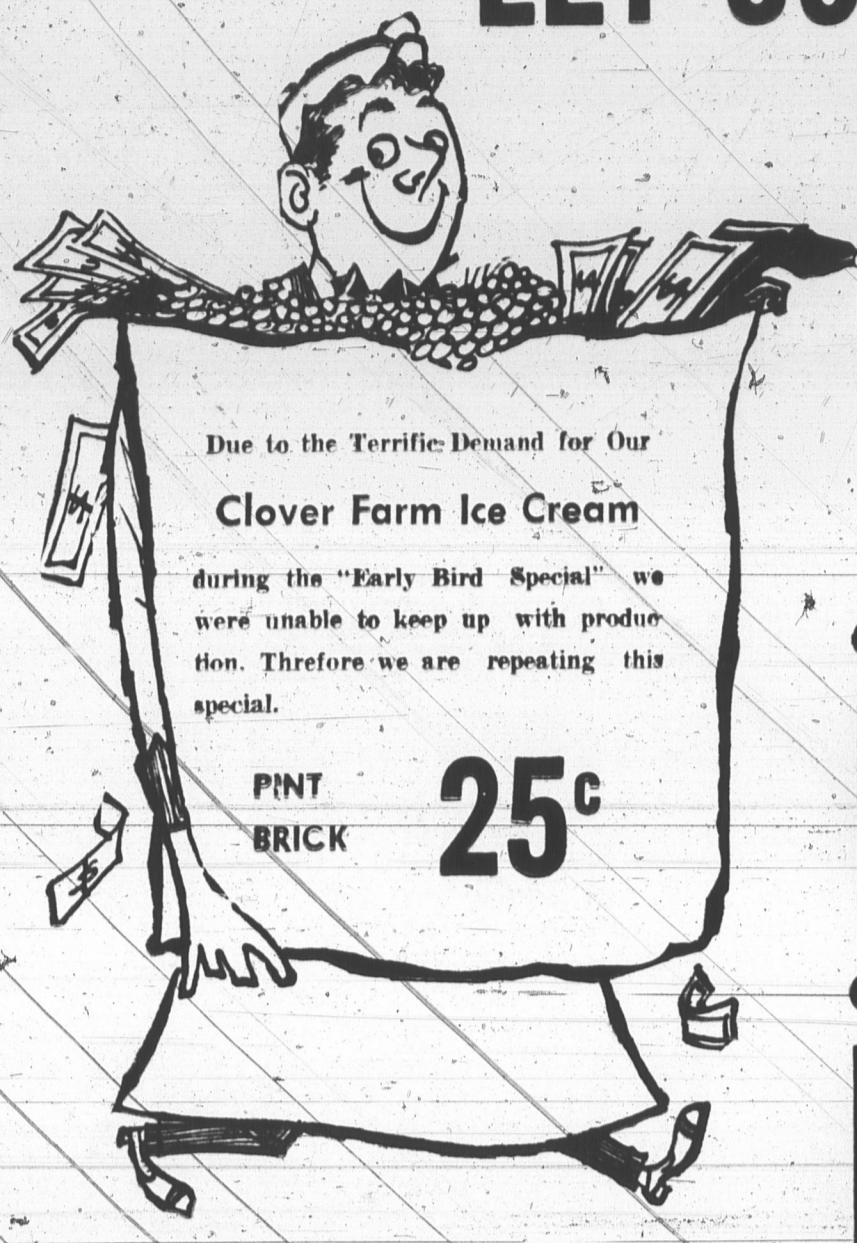
