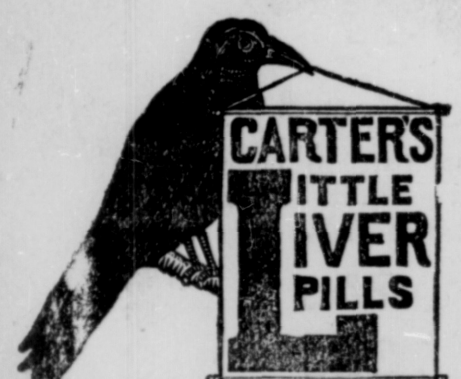
CONCERT AT UIGG.
